- Next big date, at 15 years and 6 months old, take the written driving test at an Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicle Exam Station.
- Upon passing the test at an Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicle Exam Station with a 75% or higher, the student will be issued a Temporary Instruction Permit Identification Card (known as a TIPIC) and can now legally drive with a parent or guardian.
